PARISH OF MARTOCK

We have now been informed that there will not be an election to fill the 2 Vacancies for a Parish Councillor. The Parish Council will therefore proceed to fill the vacancies by co-option. If you live or work in the Parish of Martock and would like to apply to join the Parish Council, please submit a short, written résumé covering:

- biographical background
- why they want to become a Parish Councillor
- what they feel they can contribute to the Parish Council in terms of their interests, skills and experience

To be eligible as a Parish Councillor you must:

- be a British Citizen or a citizen of the Commonwealth or European Union;
- be 18 years old or more;
- for the whole of the 12 months prior to nomination:
- have been an elector of the parish and either occupied or owned/rented premises within the parish, or
- resided within 3 miles of the boundary of the parish, or
- had your principal or only workplace within that area.

You cannot stand for election if you:

- are the subject of a bankruptcy restriction order or interim order;
- have, within 5 years of the day of election, been convicted in the United Kingdom of any offence and have had a prison sentence (whether suspended or not) for a period of over 3 months without the option of a fine;
- work for the council that you want to become a councillor for.
